1 Registration and President's Opening

2 Minutes of November 2021 meeting

MR talked to Alexandre Paulino in Jan, 2022

The problem still is that former pres of ASV POR is the only one with access to account but is not available / cannot be reached. Communication with POR very difficult. No official contact to ASV POR, we do not know who president is, etc. therefore it seems there is no ASV POR at the moment.

As per Minutes of Winter Meeting, no sailor of ASV POR shall participate in the Worlds before at least one of the past years' CIV has been paid. However, individual sailors could still participate with CIV permission, if no ASV POR exists.

TPC will talk to Alexandre Paulino during the Spanish Championship and explain the situation. It is important to inform Portuguese sailors when they enter for the World Championship.

The main goal should be to have many sailors from all countries participating in the Worlds.

CIV recalls to all NVCA that a list of participants of each NVCA for the World Championship shall be submitted to CIV before entry deadline. CIV will then forward this list to the Organizing Club.

5 2022 World Championship in Vigo

a. Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions

TPC thanks for all the contributions and remarks on the Draft NoR. The new last day of the World Championship will be Friday, July 29, agreed unanimously.

TPC proposes two alternative schedules: 4 days racing or 5 days racing.

4 days racing is approved. In this case, the rest day will be also a reserve day.

b. Charter boats and lenders for non-European crews

ASV ESP has 12 boats available at the moment and is working to get more and better equipped.

ASV FRA will investigate the possibility to bring 1 more.

c. Perpetual Trophy

ASV ESP understand the reason why their proposal was not fully welcomed. The simple story behind it is that 2022 is the 5th century anniversary of Elcano round the world exploration and for this reason the Spanish Navy offered Elcano's bust as a trophy for the event. ASV ESP tried to find a proper relevant assignment for this trophy. In general, all presents welcome the idea to have a perpetual trophy and collectively we should think at a proposal that is relevant to the Vaurien class.

d. Possibilities for Container Transport

ASV ITA investigated the possibility to ship boats on truck or container but due the current situations, prices are high and not stable therefore it is difficult to get a convenient price for end of July.
